 - The topics ranged from water conservation to mercury vapor emissions

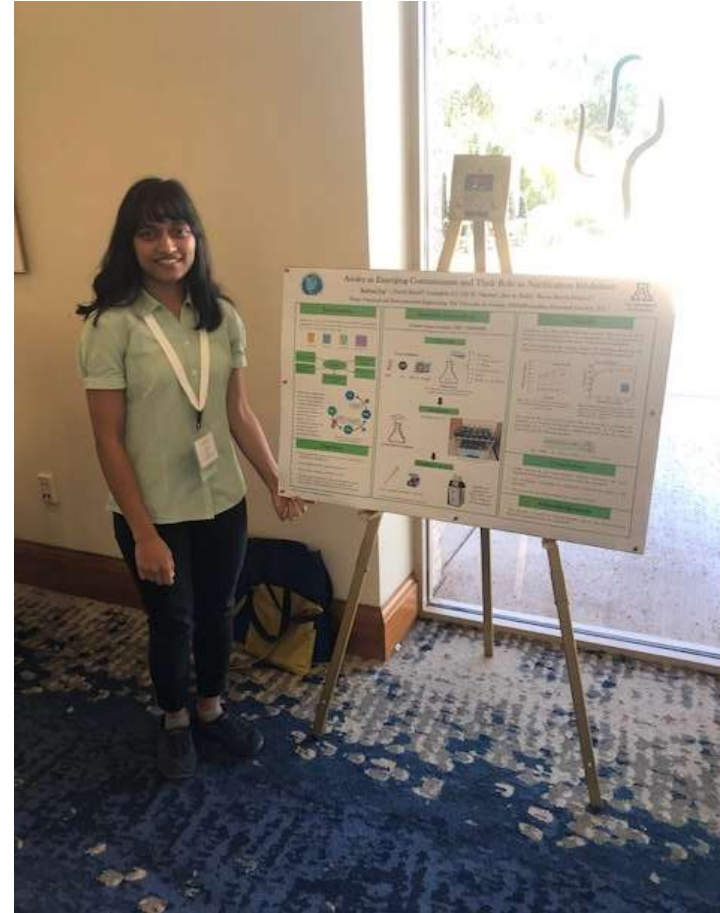
